Winemaker Notes

Intriguingly dark ruby in hue, the 2021 Stags Leap District Cabernet Sauvignon, presents a fruit-forward and expansive nose. Notes of red and blue fruits are gracefully complemented by hints of toasted oak. On the palate, it is boasting a medium body that achieves a splendid balance between its acidity and tannins. In the style of Bordeaux, it features a lighter body, offering exceptional freshness and a remarkably approachable character.
